

The Certified Grievance Committee of the Dayton Bar Association has concluded its review and investigation of your complaint against attorney Judson G. McMillin.

After completing it's investigation, the committee determined any involvement Mr. McMillin had with the "victim" outside his role as an Assistant Prosecutor occurred after he left employment at the Prosecutor's Office. Although his involvement with her after his departure may have been ill advised, the Committee did not find any ethical violations. Inasmuch as the investigation revealed no breach of professional conduct (under the Code of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Ohio) that would warrant formal disciplinary action against Mr. McMillin, the Committee is taking no further action at this time.
